Code of Conduct

As a CCFRS Youth Arts & Culture program participant I will:

- Show respect to staff and cooperate fully with their instructions.
- Know and follow the rules of the program in which I am participating.
- Respect the rights and beliefs of others and treat others with kindness.
- Communicate in an appropriate manner; foul language/gestures are not tolerated.
- Act responsibly; horseplay, teasing, unkind actions are not tolerated.
- Use program equipment, supplies, and facilities properly.
- Respect the property of others.
- I will not disrupt the program and/or hinder the learning experience of others.
- Always remain with the group and not leave the program without permission.
- Will not cause harm to other participants or staff pushing, kicking, hitting or fighting are not tolerated.

Conduct Management

Minor incidents will be brought to the student's attention and suggestions will be made on how to correct the behavior. Continued violation will result in notification of the parent. Staff will seek parental support to resolve issues and to encourage positive program participation. Participants who remain disruptive after consultation may be dismissed from the program.
